64 The Municipal Council shall hold regular meetings on the first and third
65 Tuesday of each month at ~~7:30~~ p.m. except as may be otherwise provided by
66 law or as the Council may direct by resolution published as provided in Section
67 52-4-6~~202(2)~~, Utah Code, as amended. Public notice of any Municipal Council
68 meeting shall be given as provided in Section 52-4-6~~202~~, Utah Code, as amended.

73 A. If a provision of this Ordinance 2012-21 conflicts with a provision of a previously
74 adopted ordinance concerning the same title, chapter, and/or section number amended herein, the
75 provision in this ordinance shall prevail.

77 B. This ordinance and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are hereby declared to
78 be severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid,
79 the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

81 C. The Municipal Council hereby directs that the official copy of the Provo City Code be
82 updated to reflect the provisions enacted by this ordinance.

84 D. This ordinance shall take effect beginning September 1, 2012.
