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 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2.10.070 (EXECUTIVE COMMITTEES AND MISCELLANEOUS BOARDS), 2.20.010 (PERMANENT CITY ADMINISTRATIVE AND/OR COUNCIL BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COUNCILS, AGENCIES, FOUNDATIONS AND DISTRICTS NAMED), AND 2.20.030 (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) OF THE PROVO CITY CODE AND ENACTING CHAPTER 14.04B (TRANSPORTATION AND MOBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE) OF THE PROVO CITY CODE TO CREATE THE TRANSPORTATION AND MOBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (12-00140A)

WHEREAS, it is proposed that Chapter 14.04B of the Provo City Code be enacted to provide for the creation of, and set forth the scope and duties of, the Transportation and Mobility Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed that Sections 2.10.070, 2,20.010, and 2.20.030 of the Provo City Code be amended to include the Transportation and Mobility Advisory Committee in the lists of approved City Committees; and

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2012, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing to consider the proposal and after such hearing the Planning Commission recommended to the Municipal Council the ordinance be amended as proposed; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2012, the Municipal Council held a duly noticed public hearing to receive public comments and ascertain the facts regarding this matter, which facts and comments are found in the hearing record; and

WHEREAS, all persons for and against the proposed ordinance amendment were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, after considering the Planning Commission's recommendation, and facts and comments presented to the Municipal Council, the Council finds (i) the Provo City Code should be amended on the basis recommended by the Planning Commission and (ii) the ordinance amendment, as set forth below, reasonably furthers the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Provo City.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Municipal Council of Provo City, Utah, as follows:

PART I:

Section 2.10.070 of the Provo City Code is hereby amended as follows:

2.10.070. Executive Committees and Miscellaneous Boards.

- (1) The Mayor may administratively establish, from City personnel and private citizens, committees to assist and provide counsel.
- (2) Various boards, committees and commissions established under the Provo City Code or otherwise by ordinance, other than legislative committees, shall report to and coordinate with or have liaison with the Mayor or the Mayor's designee unless otherwise stipulated by State Code. These organizations include, but are not limited to the: Provo City Library Board, Civil Service Commission, Board of Adjustment, Planning Commission, Transportation and Mobility Advisory Committee, Airport Board, Power Board, Parks and Recreation Board, Senior Citizen's Advisory Board, Parking Committee, Freedom Festival Board, Building Inspection Board of Appeals.
- (3) Other boards, committees or commissions not otherwise provided for in this administrative code portion of the Provo City Code or other administrative ordinances when reporting to the executive branch shall report to, coordinate with or have City liaison with the Mayor or the Mayor's designee.

121	(1) There is hereby created a Transportation and Mobility Advisory Committee (TMAC)
122	which shall consist of seven (7) members and two (2) alternates. Membership shall consist of
123	one resident from each of the five (5) Municipal Council Districts who will represent the
124	transportation interests of each district as well as those of the city as a whole. One (1) member
125	shall be a member of the Planning Commission. Membership should also consist of at least one
126	representative of college level transportation academia and at least one representative of a
127	business or community oriented organization. A member of the Municipal Council shall be
128	appointed to act as liaison with the TMAC, but the Municipal Council liaison shall not be
129	considered a member of the TMAC. A member of the City Engineering Division and a member

130	of the Police Department shall be appointed to act as liaison to the TMAC, but neither shall be
131	considered a member of the TMAC.
132	(2) The Mayor shall, with the advice and consent of the Municipal Council, designate
133	three (3) members to serve one (1) year, three (3) members to serve two (2) years, and three (3)
134	members to serve three (3) years. Thereafter, all appointments shall be made for a three (3) year
135	term. After the initial appointment in establishing the TMAC, members shall be limited to no
136	more than two (2) consecutive three (3) year terms each. Each person shall perform service on a
137	voluntary basis without compensation and on such basis shall be immune from liability with
138	respect to any recommendation or action taken during the course of those services. Vacancies
139	occurring in the membership of the board shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor with the
140	advice and consent of the Municipal Council for the unexpired term.
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142	14.04B.020. Powers and Duties - Procedure.
143	(1) Except as set forth in this Chapter, the TMAC shall be organized and operate as
144	described in Section 2.20.020, Provo City Code and shall meet as often as it deems necessary to
145	carry out its duties. However, the TMAC should convene for regular meetings to be held
146	throughout the year.
147	(2) All actions taken by the TMAC shall constitute recommendations to the Mayor, the
148	Municipal Council, the Planning Commission, and to other city commissions and boards and
149	shall not constitute official action. The Mayor, Municipal Council, and the Planning Commission
150	shall have the power to review, ratify, modify or disregard recommendations submitted by the
151	TMAC.
152	(3) The TMAC shall:
153	(a) Determine and establish such rules and regulations for the conduct of the
154	board as the members shall deem advisable; provided, however, that such rules and
155	regulations shall not be in conflict with this chapter or its successor, or other city, state or
156	federal law;
157	(b) Monitor the status of and make recommendations for amendments to the city's
158	Vision 2030 document, the General Plan, transportation master plan, the major and local
159	street plan, and any other planning document that impacts transportation and mobility
160	with in the city;
161	(c) Recommend the adoption and alteration of all rules, regulations and
162	ordinances which it shall deem in the public interest and for the purposes of carrying out
163	the objects of the Provo City Code as it relates to transportation and mobility;
164	(d) Review regional, citywide and significant local transportation and mobility
165	issues as they relate to and are effected by land use policy, balancing the interests and
166	needs of private vehicles, public transportation, bicycles, and pedestrians;
167	(i) Provide recommendations to the Mayor, Municipal Council, Planning
168	Commission, and other city commissions and boards regarding the priority, funding, and
169	design of capital improvement projects that relate to transportation and mobility:

170	(j) Serve as a coordination body and resource for organizations interested in
171	transportation and mobility issues affecting the city;
172	(f) Promote public education of transportation and mobility issues affecting the
173	city and its residents;
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175	PART V:
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177	A. If a provision of this Ordinance 2012 conflicts with a provision of a previously
178	adopted ordinance concerning the same title, chapter, and/or section number amended herein, the
179	provision in this ordinance shall prevail.
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181	B. This ordinance and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are hereby declared to
182	be severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid,
183	the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
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185	C. The Municipal Council hereby directs that the official copy of the Provo City Code be
186	updated to reflect the provisions enacted by this ordinance.
