

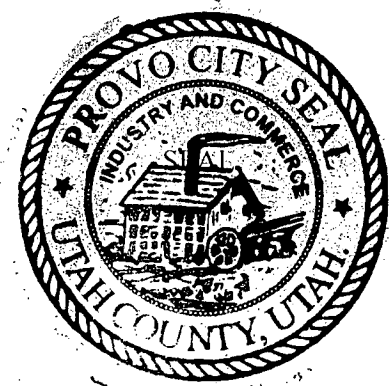

52 ~~a numerical number indicating the location.~~ Those streets which are not parallel to the
53 coordinate system shall be named in accordance to the Street Naming Procedures set forth by the
54 Public Works Department - Engineering Division.

56 **15.13.030. System to be Followed.**

57 The City Engineer, in numbering houses upon the streets of the City, shall adhere in all
58 respects to the following system of numeration, allowing fifty (50) numbers to each side of all
59 coordinates within the City limits; the initial points shall be the intersection of University
60 Avenue and Center Street, and the numbering shall extend east and west, and north and south,
61 the even numbers always on the right hand, and the odd numbers always on the left hand,
62 looking away from the initial point. The addressing system shall follow in accordance to the
63 Address Standards set forth by the Public Works Department – Engineering Division.

65 **15.13.040. Costs Related to Street Name Changes.**

66 Any person who petitions for a change in the name of a street or alley shall, unless the
67 Mayor for good cause otherwise directs, pay the cost of notification, processing, staff review,
68 and making and installing new street signs, required by the name change.

70 **15.13.040. Costs Related to Street Name Changes.**

71 Any person who petitions for a change in the name of a street or alley shall, unless the
72 Mayor for good cause otherwise directs, pay the cost of making and installing new street signs
73 required by the name change.

74
75 **15.13.050. Street Coordinates on Street Signs.**

76 Street signs erected by the City to show the name of a street shall also include on the face
77 thereof the correct street coordinates.

79 **PART II:**

81 A. If a provision of this Ordinance 2013-07 conflicts with a provision of a previously
82 adopted ordinance concerning the same title, chapter, and/or section number amended herein, the
83 provision in this ordinance shall prevail.

84
85 B. This ordinance and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are hereby declared to
86 be severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid,
87 the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

89 C. The Municipal Council hereby directs that the official copy of the Provo City Code be
90 updated to reflect the provisions enacted by this ordinance.

92 D. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after being posted or published as
93 required by law.
