8	WHEREAS, it is proposed that an amendment be made to Provo City Code Sections
9	6.32.030 and 9.15.150 to create a public atmosphere conducive to the cautious, efficient, and
10	easy flow of both pedestrian and vehicular traffic on sidewalks, in parking areas, on streets and
11	in the public right of way; and
12	WHEREAS, mobile vendors of food, goods or services use portions of the sidewalk,
13	parking areas, street, or the public right of way; and
14	WHEREAS, mobile vendors on sidewalks, in parking areas, on the street, or the public
15	right of way unavoidably disrupt the free flow of foot or vehicular traffic when high volume use
16	creates congestion; and
17	WHEREAS, disruption of the orderly flow of traffic; delay; vehicle idling and air
18	pollution; and motorist frustration, annoyance, and hostility result from impaired traffic flow;
19	and
20	WHEREAS, congestion in or on sidewalks, parking areas, streets, and the public right of
21	way contributes to accidents, property damage, and injury; and
22	WHEREAS, on December 1, 2015, the Municipal Council held a duly noticed public
23	meeting to ascertain the facts regarding this matter, which facts are found in the meeting record;
24	and
25	WHEREAS, after considering the facts and comments presented to the Municipal
26	Council, the Council finds (i) Provo City Code Sections 6.32.030 and 9.15.150 should be
27	amended and (ii) this action, as set forth below, reasonably furthers the health, safety and general
28	welfare of the citizens of Provo City.

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Municipal Council of Provo City, Utah, as

31 follows:

#### PART I:

Provo City Code Section 6.32.030 is hereby amended as follows:

# 6.32.030. Mobile Food Business General Requirements.

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36 (6) Notwithstanding Subsection (1)-(5) of this Section 6.32.030, mobile food businesses may not

operate in the public right of way during large public gatherings along designated high traffic 37

38 volume corridors which have been previously outlined in a Special Events Permit issued by 39

Provo City, provided that public safety personnel on the City Special Events Review Committee

have made a specific finding that the anticipated weather and/or traffic conditions require such

41 limitations in order to preserve public safety and reduce gridlock.

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#### PART II:

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Provo City Code Section 9.15.150 is hereby amended as follows:

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# 9.15.150. Regulation of Street Sales.

(1) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation or employee thereof to use the City streets, or sidewalks, or public right of way for the purpose of displaying for sale or for selling of any goods of service or to obstruct traffic, either pedestrian or vehicular or to preempt or occupy parking places or any portion of the public thoroughfare in selling or attempting to sell goods or services, without first obtaining a written permit from the Chief of PoliceCity. A mobile food business license issued under Chapter 6.20 shall constitute a written permit under this Section for a mobile food business operating in compliance with that Chapter.

(2) This Section shall not be interpreted to prevent the owner of an automobile desiring the same to display a for sale sign in the owner's personal automobile, nor shall it prohibit the sale of goods and services on holiday or special occasions declared by Provo City or generally recognized as a holiday in the community when such activities are carried on in such a way as to not interfere with vehicular traffic.

# PART III:

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A. If a provision of this ordinance conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted ordinance, this ordinance shall prevail.

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B. This ordinance and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

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- C. The Municipal Council hereby directs that the official copy of the Provo City Code be updated to reflect the provisions enacted by this ordinance.
   D. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been posted or published in
