



73 Provo City Code Section 4.04.125 (Elected Officials Compensation Commission) is
74 hereby enacted as follows:
75

76 **4.04.125. Elected Officials Compensation Commission.**
77

78 (1) There is hereby created an Elected Officials Compensation Commission which shall consist
79 of three (3) residents of Provo selected by the Mayor, three (3) residents of Provo selected by a
80 majority of the Municipal Council, and one (1) additional resident of Provo selected by a
81 majority of the other six (6) members of the Commission. Commission members shall be
82 appointed in February of 2017 and thereafter in February every four years.
83

84 (2) The Commission is tasked with reviewing the results of a salary survey conducted by the
85 Human Resources Division of:
86

87 (a) Mayoral compensation in cities and counties in Utah with a full-time elected mayor,
88 and
89

90 (b) Council Member compensation in cities and counties in Utah with part-time Council
91 members.
92

93 (3) In a public meeting of the Municipal Council and no later than the first regularly scheduled
94 Council Meeting in April, the Commission shall then recommend to the Mayor and the
95 Municipal Council:

96 (a) an annual salary for the Mayor,

97 (b) an annual salary for Municipal Council Members,

98 (c) additional remuneration set forth in 4.04.110(3), and

99 (d) any other compensation matters the Commission considers pertinent.

100 (4) After receipt of the recommendations of the Commission, the Municipal Council shall hold a
101 vote upon said recommendations no later than the third Tuesday in June and shall by majority
102 vote establish any change in the annual compensation for the Mayor and/or Municipal Council
103 Members by ordinance. Compensation for the Mayor and Municipal Council Members shall be
104 considered in two separate ordinances.

105 (5) Compensation adjustments occurring under this Section shall be effective:

106 (a) at the beginning of the pay period that includes the first Monday in January of the
107 following year for incumbents who are re-elected or continuing their term; and

108 (b) on the first day of their term of office for newly elected officials.

109 (6) The term of the Commission members will expire at the time the Municipal Council acts
110 pursuant to Subsection (4).

111 PART III:

112 A. If a provision of this ordinance conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted
113 ordinance, this ordinance shall prevail.

114 B. This ordinance and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are hereby declared to be
115 severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or
116 invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

117 C. The Municipal Council hereby directs that the official copy of the Provo City Code be
118 updated to reflect the provisions enacted by this ordinance.

119 D. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been posted or published in
120 accordance with Utah Code 10-3-711, presented to the Mayor in accordance with Utah
121 Code 10-3b-204, and recorded in accordance with Utah Code 10-3-713.
