

7 WHEREAS, it is proposed that Provo City Code Section 15.03.020 (General
8 Development Standards) be amended to update the references to local development standards;
9 and

11 WHEREAS, on November 9, 2022, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed public
12 hearing to consider the proposed amendment, and after such meeting, the Planning Commission
13 recommended approval to the Municipal Council by a vote of 6:0; and

14
15 WHEREAS, on November 15, 2022, the Municipal Council met to ascertain the facts
16 regarding this matter and receive public comment, which facts and comments are found in the
17 public record of the Council’s consideration; and

18
19 WHEREAS, after considering the Planning Commission's recommendation and facts and
20 comments presented to the Municipal Council, the Council finds (i) Provo City Code should be
21 amended as described herein and (ii) the proposed amendment reasonably furthers the health,
22 safety and general welfare of the citizens of Provo City.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Municipal Council of Provo City, Utah, as
25 follows:

27 PART I:

29 Provo City Code Section 15.03.020 is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A.

31 PART II:

33 A. If a provision of this ordinance conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted
34 ordinance, this ordinance shall prevail.

36 B. This ordinance and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are hereby
37 declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be
38 unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected
39 thereby.

41 C. The Municipal Council hereby directs that the official copy of the Provo City
42 Code be updated to reflect the provisions enacted by this ordinance.

44 D. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been posted or published
45 in accordance with Utah Code 10-3-711, presented to the Mayor in accordance
46 with Utah Code 10-3b-204, and recorded in accordance with Utah Code 10-3-713.

Exhibit A

Section 15.03.020. General Development Standards.

...

(3) Provo City adopts and incorporates by reference into this section:

(a) The following nationally recognized, industry standards:

- (i) Manual of Standard Specifications, 2017, American Public Works Association;
- (ii) Manual of Standard Plans, 2017, American Public Works Association;
- (iii) Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways (the "MUTCD"), 2009 Edition, Federal Highway Administration;
- (iv) A Policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets, 6th Edition, American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials;
- (v) Trip Generation Manual, 10th Edition, Institute of Transportation Engineers; and

(b) The following local standards, which supersede those standards adopted by Subsection (3)(a) of this Section to the extent there is any conflict:

- (i) ~~2022~~2023 Provo Standard Drawing Details;
- (ii) ~~2022~~2023 Provo City Public Works Department Development Design Standards;
- (iii) Utah Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, For Streets and Highways, (FHWA's MUTCD 2009 Edition as amended for use in Utah), 2011, Utah Department of Transportation;
- (iv) 2017 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, 2017, Utah Department of Transportation;
- (v) 2017 Standard Drawings for Road and Bridge Construction, 2017, Utah Department of Transportation; and

(vi) Utah Administrative Rules Titles R305-R317
