7	WHEREAS, it is proposed that Provo City Code Section 14.23.090 be amended to
8	remove the step-back requirement in the Interim Transit Oriented Development (ITOD) Zone;
9	and
10	WHEREAS, on September 27, 2023, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed
11 12	public hearing to consider the proposed amendment, and after such meeting, the Planning
13	Commission recommended approval to the Municipal Council by a vote of 9:0; and
14	Commission recommended approval to the intumerpal Council by a vote of 5.0, and
15	WHEREAS, on October 17, 2023, the Municipal Council met to ascertain the facts
16	regarding this matter and receive public comment, which facts and comments are found in the
17	public record of the Council's consideration; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, after considering the Planning Commission's recommendation and facts and
20	comments presented to the Municipal Council, the Council finds (i) Provo City Code should be
21	amended as described herein and (ii) the proposed amendment reasonably furthers the health,
22	safety and general welfare of the citizens of Provo City.

24	NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Municipal Council of Provo City, Utah, as
25	follows:
26	DADE I
27	PART I:
28	Drave City Code Section 14 22 000 is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A
29 30	Provo City Code Section 14.23.090 is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A.
31	
32	PART II:
33	
34	A. If a provision of this ordinance conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted
35	ordinance, this ordinance shall prevail.

B. This ordinance and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

 C. The Municipal Council hereby directs that the official copy of the Provo City Code be updated to reflect the provisions enacted by this ordinance.

45	D.	This ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been posted or published
46		in accordance with Utah Code 10-3-711, presented to the Mayor in accordance
47		with Utah Code 10-3b-204, and recorded in accordance with Utah Code 10-3-713.

Exhibit A

50	14.23.090 – Building Height.
51	The total maximum building height within the ITOD zone shall not exceed one hundred (100) feet
52	according to the following:
53	 Building height shall be measured in number of stories, excluding basement areas;
54	(2) Each building shall not have less than two (2) stories. The fifth story and each story above it
55	shall have an additional setback of no less than fifteen (15) feet from the first story building
56	elevation adjacent to any street;
57	(3) Each story within the ITOD zone shall not exceed fourteen (14) feet except for first story
58	commercial functions may be up to twenty feet (20);
59	(4) Parapet walls and cornices shall not exceed five (5) feet, except as otherwise provided in
60	Section 14.34.090, Provo City Code;
61	(5) Residential main floor level shall not exceed three (3) feet in height above street curb
62	elevation;
63	(6) Commercial main floor level shall not exceed one (1) foot in height above street curb
64	elevation; and
65	(7) Mechanical equipment shall be screened. Only the minimal amount of screening necessary to
66	fully screen such equipment shall be used. Mechanical equipment shall be setback in such
67	manner that the required screening cannot be seen from the pedestrian street view, if possible.
